Continuous Improvement and School Vision

- Currently, all necessary safety drills have been conducted for the year. Ongoing work with CPD to ensure school is prepared in the case of an law enforcement emergency
- Repairs made to roof and pipes that led to leaking that damaged 3rd grade classroom. Students and teacher have moved back to classroom.
